2025 PROPERTY TAX NOTICES

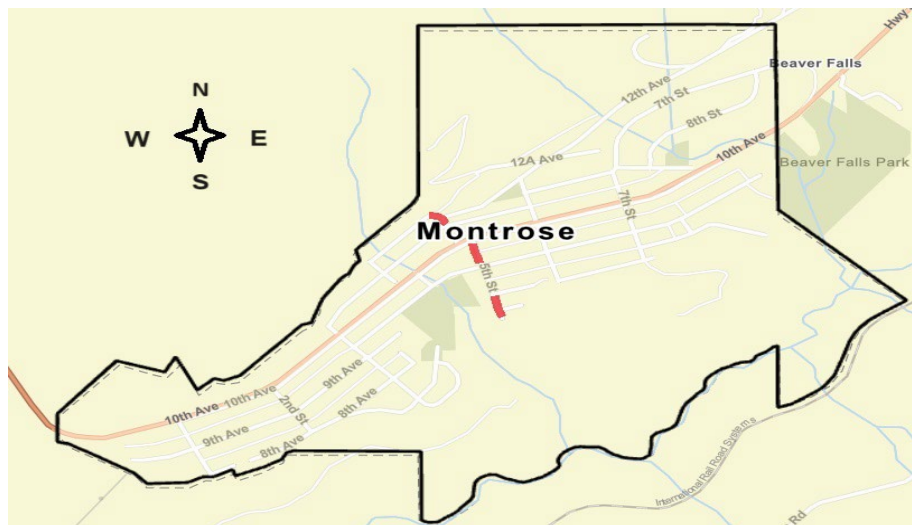
Property taxes are due on **Wednesday, July 2, 2025**. If you have not received your property tax notice, please contact the Village Office at **250-367-7234**.
If you are eligible, don't forget to claim your **Provincial Homeowner Grant** online by the due date – July 2nd.

WATER CONSERVATION REGULATIONS

as per Bylaw #702 "Water Conservation and Staging Restrictions Regulations"

- Houses east of 5th Street water on even numbered days
- Houses west of 5th Street water on odd numbered days
- Underground sprinklers between 12:00 am and 4:00 am on permitted days
- Watering with sprayer hoes and other sprinklers between 6:00 am and 8:00 am and 6:00 pm and 8:00 pm on permitted days
- **NO SPRINKLING ON THE 31ST OF ANY MONTH**

If Village Council needs to enact further regulations within Bylaw #702 "Water Conservation and Staging Restrictions Regulations", residents will be advised.



PROPERTY MAINTENANCE

As per Bylaw #779 - Owners must keep grassed areas trimmed and free of all weeds. All property must be kept free from unsightly debris, derelict vehicles, overgrown weeds, and offensive materials. Adjacent areas to sidewalks, boulevards and alleyways must be kept tidy and the vegetation trimmed.
