Help keep Montrose beautiful by keeping lawns trimmed and properties free of weeds, debris, and unsightly materials—including boulevards and laneways. Remember to pick ripe fruit from trees to avoid attracting bears and other nuisance wildlife.

The Village has had an increase in complaints about speeding. Please slow down and drive with care—for the safety of your neighbours and the entire community.

Water Conservation Regulations

To conserve water, the following rules apply year-round in Montrose:

- No lawn or garden watering (sprinklers, soaker hoses, etc.) between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.
- Even days: Watering allowed east of 5th Street •
- Odd days: Watering allowed west of 5th Street •
- No watering on the 31st of any month
- **One watering device at a time** per property (manual watering with cans are okay anytime) •
- No washing vehicles or buildings with a running hose unless it has a flow-restriction nozzle •
- Automated underground sprinklers: Allowed only 12:00 a.m. - 4:00 a.m. on permitted days
- Other sprinklers: Allowed only 6:00-8:00 a.m. and 6:00-8:00 p.m. on permitted days •
- Properties with underground sprinklers cannot use additional watering devices

Further restrictions may be introduced under Bylaw #702 if needed.
